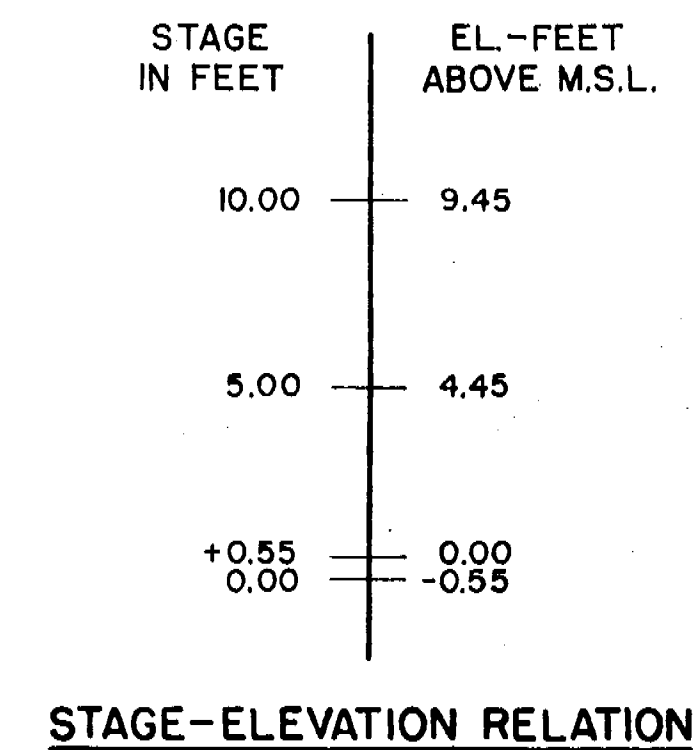




NOTES:
