It was about a foot and a half in diameter saucer shaped to a depth of about four inches according to Foreman's memory. He did not cut through the concrete base. It is within two or three feet of a Hfd.Elec.Lt.Co. manhole which may mean that the settlement was over some of their underground work. Permanent repairs have not yet been made.
